Parents received the scaled scores of test with the reports.

Year 2 results are broadly in line with national results. This year the school's assessments were externally moderated by two local authority moderators. The last time the school was moderated was in 2013. We were therefore due for external moderation as this is every 4 years. Our school has been praised and one of the schools mentioned as having outstanding assessment practice. All the school's judgements were in line with the external moderators.
